for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 14, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 50 feet North 40 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 19, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 19, Township 23 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 23 South, Range 12 West, WM Section 19 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86
