PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64505 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ted C. Neward of Route 1, Box 206, Banks, Oregon 97106, phone 324-7901, for the use of the waters of Garrigus Creek, Rock Creek and two reservoirs, a tributary of West Fork Dairy Creek, under Application R-67689, Permit R-9602, being* for the PURPOSE Creek are 170.5 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from the 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed.75 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED version 1A (Rock Creek) - 600 feet North and 350 feet West from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 11, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 11; Diversion 1(B) (Rock Creek) - 400 feet North and 100 feet East from the Southeast Corner of the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14; Diversion 2 (Garrigus Creek) - 800 **

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* 0.16 cubic foot per second from Garrigus Creek, 0.59 cfs from Rock Creek, 20.0 acre-feet from reservoir (Pond 1), and 6.0 af from reservoir (Pond 2),

feet North and 900 feet East; Diversion 3 - (Rock Creek) 350 feet North and 700 feet East; Diversion 4 (Pond 1) - 750 feet North and 600 feet East, from the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 14, all being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 14; Diversion 5 (Pond 2) - 1990 feet South and 2050 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 14, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 14; Diversion 6 - 50 feet North and 250 feet West from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 11, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 11, all within Township 2 North, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre from direct flow and storage from reservoirs to be constructed under Permits R-9602, provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
