PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68002 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Saint Peter's Church of 10th and Cherry Heights, The Dalles, Oregon 97058, phone 296-2026, for the use of the waters of Mill Creek, a tributary of Columbia River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 24.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 25, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.4 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1660 feet South and 2110 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 4, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 4, Township 1 North, Range 13 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 North, Range 13 East, WM Section 4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 5.2 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 7.0 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 1.7 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4 10.1 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/60 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 19, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87 . Extended to October 1, 1989
