PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 58687 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

s permit is issued to Crystal Springs Packing Co., c/o Duane Culbertson of 327 South Fir Street, Medford, Oregon 97501, phone 772-4298, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Bear Creek, when available with any deficiency in * for the PURPOSE of temperature control

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

May 21, 1979

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.5 cubic second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Unnamed Stream and Reservoir 1 - 1400 feet North and 2550 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 27, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 27; Mud Creek - 150 feet North and 1250 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 26, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 26, both in Township 37 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

supply from the unnamed stream to be made up be appropriation from Mud Creek and CSPC Reservoir 1 to be constructed under Application R-58686, Permit R-9684,

Township 37 South, Range 1 West, WM Section 27 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 0.9 acre Temperature SW 1/4 19.8 acres control NE 1/4 SE 1/4 14.0 acres NW 1/4

The permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control (frost control) on forms furnished.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 7, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87
