PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64532 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Paul H. Klindt of PO Box 7; Bob McIsaac and Pat Petteys of 7200 Old Pk. Dale Road, Parkdale, Oregon 97041, phone 352-7246 and 352-7911, for the use of the waters of McIsaac Spring, a tributary of Trout Creek,

for the PURPOSE of commercial use at labor camps, dehydration factory and warehouse and domestic supplies for six families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden per family, being 0.07 cubic foot per second for * that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 9, 1982 for 0.07 cfs and March 2, 1983 for 0.03 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 3150 feet South and 550 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 1, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 1 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Hood River.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

commercial use and 0.03 cfs for domestic use

Township 1 North, Range 10 East, WM Section 31 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use (2 homesites)

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use (1 homesite)

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Labor camp

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Dehydration factory

Section 32 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Warehouse

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use (1 homesite)

Township 1 South, Range 9 East, WM Section 1 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use (2 homesites)

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Labor camp

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 7, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
