PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67726 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Brian Mische of 3303 Hwy. 238, Jacksonville, Oregon 97530, phone 899-7323, for the use of the waters of two springs; being 0.01 cfs from each spring,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for three families including the irrigation of not to exceed one—half acre lawn and noncommercial garden for each

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from ()(

October 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 CUbic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1-1365 feet North and 720 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 12; Diversion 2-1420 North and 1220 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 12, both being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 12 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for three families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden for each

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 7, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87
