PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **67453** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Eleanore and Kenneth Purdy of PO Box 4429, Medford, Oregon 97501, phone 772-2563,** for the use of the waters of **East Swedenburg Orchard Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-67452, Permit R-9688,** for the PURPOSE of **frost control**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **October 10, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **9.1 acre-feet SWO**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **830 feet North and 1085 feet West from the Southeast Corner of SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control (frost control) on forms furnished.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **May 14, 1985** , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **86**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **87**.
