The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre from direct flow and storage from reservoirs constructed under Permit R-5363 and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 7-07-10-W0066 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 30, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1987 .
