## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66943 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Roy C. Simpson and I. June Simpson of 6151 Willis Creek Road, Winston, Oregon 97496, phone 679-7743, for the use of the waters of Willis Creek and a spring, tributaries of South Umpqua River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 1.0 acre and domestic use for one family, being 0.01 cfs from Willis Creek for irrigation and 0.005 cfs from the spring for domestic

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

September 28, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.015 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 630 feet South and 1160 feet East; Diversion 2 - 600 feet South and 870 feet East, both from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 21, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 21, Township 29 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 21 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 1.0 acre and Domestic use

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 30, 1985 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
