PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67108 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

John E. Beall and Dorothy Pearl Beall of 14215 NE Beach Street, Portland, Oregon 97201, phone 255-0813, for the use of the waters of an unnamed slough, a tributary of Willamette Slough, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 111.2 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 12, 1984

1.39 cubic foot per and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed second

836.4 feet North and 1408.0 feet East from the Southeast The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Corner of Matthew White DLC, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 2 North, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Multnomah.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Section 14 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 4.5 acres Township 2 North, Range 1 West, WM Section 15 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 17.3 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 1.2 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 2.3 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 23.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4 12.5 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4 37.8 acres Section 22 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 11.2 acres Section 23 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 1.4 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 30, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
