## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68009 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Helmut Fink of 17617 Abiqua Road, NE, Silverton, Oregon 97381, phone 873-8764, for the use of the waters of Alder Creek, a tributary of Abiqua Creek, for the maintenance of two reservoirs to be constructed under Application R-68008, Permit R-9809, for the PURPOSE of maintenance of two reservoirs for fish culture

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

January 30, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed second 0.02 cubic foot per

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 450 feet North and 370 feet West; Diversion 2 - 580 feet North and 210 feet West both from the Southeast Corner of Section 28, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 28, Township 6 South, Range 1 East, WM, in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 South, Range 1 East, WM Section 28 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Fish hatchery Section 28 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Fish hatchery

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 30, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86,

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
