PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **64818** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Metropolitan Wastewater Management Commission (MIMC)** of 225 North 5th Street, Suite 292, Springfield, Oregon 97477, phone 747-4551, for the use of the waters of cannery wastewater and a reservoir to be constructed under Application R-64817, * for the PURPOSE of irrigation of crops for disposal of cannery wastewater

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **January 31, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **2.36 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Agripac Cannery - 1060 feet South and 520 feet East 368 feet from the Northwest Corner of Section 32, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 32, Township 17 South, Range 4 West; Wastewater Pond - 90 feet North and 460 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 27, Township 16 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Lane.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre, and is subject to the terms and provisions of an Order of the Water Resources Director dated October 13, 1983, and recorded at Volume 37, page 503, Special Order Records.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **June 15, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **86**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **87**.
