## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68013 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

irrigation of 39.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 24, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.49 cubic foot

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 425 feet North and 790 feet East from the Quarter Corner of Sections 28 and 33, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 28, Township 2 North, Range 13 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 North, Range 13 East, WM Section 28 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 1.7 acres Irrigation NW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.1 acre Section 29 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.7 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4 3.9 acres Section 33 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 8.3 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 22, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
