PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68071 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following 68071 limitations and conditions:

is permit is issued to Ronald G. Buhr of 8608 Mt. Angel Highway, Mt. Angel, Oregon 97362, phone 845-9441, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Pudding River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 25.2 acres

May 1, 1984 that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

0.32 cubic foot and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed per second

2450 feet North and 400 feet West from the Southeast The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Corner of Section 16, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 16, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Section 15 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 9.5 acres Township 6 South, Range 1 West, WM Section 16 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 15.7 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

June 22, 1985 Actual construction work shall begin on or before , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
