PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68072 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to William D. Hunter of South Coos River Route, Box 278, Coos Bay, Oregon 97420, phone 269-7961, for the use of the waters of South Fork Coos River and an unnamed stream, being 0.86 cubic foot per second from South Fork Coos River * for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 69.0 acres, stock watering, dairy barn use, and domestic use for three families, being 0.86 cfs from the South Fork Coos River for irrigation, 0.005 cfs from unnamed stream for stock watering, 0.005 cfs from ** that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 3, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.88 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 530 feet North and 1880 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 32, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 29; Diversion 2 - 2590 feet South and 60 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 32, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 32, both in Township 25 South, Range 11 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * and 0.02 cfs from the unnamed stream, tributaries of Coos River,
- ** unnamed stream for dairy barn use, and 0.01 cfs from unnamed stream for domestic use

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 22, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1987.
