68078 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Thomas D. Dunn of Forest Haven, Little River Road, Glide, Oregon This permit is issued to 97443, phone 496-0183, for the use of the waters of Little River, a tributary of North Umpqua River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 9, 1984

0.01 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 355 feet South and 305 feet East from the North 1/4 Corner of Section 12, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 27 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 27 South, Range 2 West, WM Section 12 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-eighth acre lawn and noncommercial garden

June 22, 1985 Actual construction work shall begin on or before , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
