A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 South, Range 36 East, WM Section 4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for Woodley Campground

June 28, 1985 Actual construction work shall begin on or before , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19
