PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62983 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to City of Cove of PO Box 8, Cove, Oregon 97824, phone 568-4573, for the use of the waters of Mill Creek and Bridge Creek, a tributaries of Grande Ronde River, being 6.0 cubic feet per second from each,

for the PURPOSE of hydroelectric power development of 1148 theoretical horsepower at Mill Creek Hydroelectric Project

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

October 16, 1981

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

12.0 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Bridge Creek - 165 feet South and 165 feet West from the Northeast Corner of the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 19, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 19; Mill Creek - 660 feet South and 330 feet East from the Northwest Corner of the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 30, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 30, both within Township 3 South, Range 41 East, WM, in the County of Union.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 South, Range 40 East, WM Section 24 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Hydroelectric power generation

The right granted herein is expressly made inferior in right and subsequent in time to any appropriation of water from this source which may hereafter be made for domestic, municipal, irrigation or any other beneficial consumptive use, or for storage for such purposes, provided further that the project shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered professional engineer, provided further that the permittee shall comply with the provisions of the order of the Water Policy Review Board dated October 14, 1983 and by reference herein made part of this permit.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 13, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
