PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

66599 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66599 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions

George Otis Mobley of HC 60, Box 3250, Lakeview, Oregon 97630, This permit is issued to phone 947-3435, for the use of the waters of an unnamed drainageway, a tributary of Goose Lake,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 40.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 5, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1320 feet South and 10 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 30, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 40 South, Range 19 East, WM, in the County of Lake.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 40 South, Range 19 East, WM Section 30 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 40.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet and is subject to terms and conditions of stipulation between Lakeview Water Users, Inc., and George Otis Mobley recorded at page 1221, Volume 6, Miscellaneous Records of the Water Resources Director and by reference made a part of this permit.

July 13, 1985 Actual construction work shall begin on or before , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86. Extended to 10-1-89

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
