PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **67705** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Coos County Parks Department (Frona) 1975 McPherson, Room 229, North Bend, Oregon 97459, phone 756-5112 ext. 254,** for the use of the waters of a **spring, a tributary of East Fork of Coquille River,** for the PURPOSE of **park use**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **October 13, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **1300 feet North and 220 feet West from the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 11, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 28 South, Range 11 West, WM, in the County of Coos.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Township 28 South, Range 11 West, WM Section 11 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Park use*
SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Park use***

* **Park use consists of making potable water available for washing, cooking and other uses associated with camping and picnicing.**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **July 13, 1985** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **86 Extended to October 1987**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **87.**
