PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68054** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Garrett Van Diest, Inc., of PO Box 867, Winnemucca, Nevada 89445, phone (702)623-3097,** for the use of the waters of **Pedee Creek, a tributary of Lukiamute River, and reservoir, to be constructed under Application R-68053, Permit R-9868,** for the PURPOSE of **irrigation of 35.8 acres**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **April 10, 1984 for 0.062 cfs and June 7, 1984 for 0.388 cfs**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.45 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Pedee Creek - 200 feet South and 1050 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 32, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 32; Reservoir - 10 feet North and 1750 feet East from the Southwest Corner of SE 1/4 of Section 29, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 29, all in Township 9 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-9868, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **July 13, 1985** , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1986** Extended to October 1, 1988

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1987** Extended to October 1, 1988
