PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67946 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jillian C. Barker of PO Box 572, Mosier, Oregon 97040, phone 478-3427, for the use of the waters from Stream A when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Stream A to be made up by appropriation for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 17.0 acres and domestic use for one family, being 0.20 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 14, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.285 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Spring 1-350 feet North and 2570 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 32, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 32; Spring 2-220 feet South and 3460 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 32, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 32, both within Township 2 North, Range 12 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* from Stream B, Spring 1, Spring 2 and Reservoirs 1 and 2, to be constructed under Application R-67945, Permit R-9895 for irrigation; 0.03 cubic foot per second from Spring 2 for irrigation; and 0.005 cfs from Spring 1 when available or of suitable quality with any deficiency in the available supply or at times when the water quality is not suitable at Spring 1, to be made up by appropriation from Spring 2 for domestic use provided the total quantity diverted from both springs for domestic use shall not exceed 0.005 cfs,

Township 2 North, Range 12 East, WM Section 32 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 15.0 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 2.0 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/60 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-9895, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 19, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1. 19 87.
