PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 67970 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Philomath Rural Fire District 4 of PO Box 1123, Philomath, Oregon 97370, phone 929-3002, for the use of the waters from Marys River,

for the PURPOSE of filling fire department tanker vehicles

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 22, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 750 gallons per minute

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1204 feet South and 2513 feet East from the 1/4 Corner of Section 21, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 21, Township 11 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Benton.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 11 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 21 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Fire department tanker fill station

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 19, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1987.
