PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68088 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Scharf Farms by John Scharf, Partner of 9950 Bethel Road, Amity, Oregon 97101, phone 835-6445, for the use of the waters from Ash Swale, a tributary of Salt Creek, and reservoir constructed under Permits R-2038 and R-8399, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 172.6 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 22, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1060 feet South and 750 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 19, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 19, Township 6 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 24 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 7.8 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4 20.0 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4 2.0 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4 33.4 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 8.3 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 6.6 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4 4.9 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4 23.6 acres Township 6 South, Range 4 West. WM Section 19 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 33.2 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 0.8 acre NW 1/4 SW 1/4 6.4 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4 25.6 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permits R-2038 and R-8399, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Ctual construction work shall begin on or before July 19, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 19, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
