## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **64056** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **U.S. Government - Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 882-7761,** for the use of the waters of Sand Creek, a tributary of Klamath Marsh, for the PURPOSE of **road construction, maintenance and dust abatement,** provided the total volume of water diverted shall not exceed **2.0 acre-feet per year**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 1, 1982**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **1.0 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **800 feet North and 690 feet West from the East Quarter Corner of Section 29, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 29, Township 31 South, Range 7 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **August 14, 1985** , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 19 86** .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 19 87** .
