PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64934 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

United States, Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 883-6714, for the use of the waters of Cubin Spring and Huckleberry Spring, tributaries of Jack Creek, being 0.005 cubic foot per second of * for the PURPOSE of livestock

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 18, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Spring 1 - 2240 feet North and 330 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 28, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 27 South, Range 10 East; Spring 2 0 1850 feet North and 140 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 36, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 36, Township 27 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 14, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87 .


