## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64984 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

U.S. Government - Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath This permit is issued to Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 882-7761, for the use of the waters of two unnamed springs, tributaries of Jack Creek, for the PURPOSE of livetock

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 4, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cfs from each spring,

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 790 feet North and 2770 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 24, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 24, Township 26 South, Range 9 East, WM; Diversion 2 - 2240 feet South and 1120 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 1, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 27 South, Range 9 East, WM, both being in in the County of Klamath. A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South, Range 9 East, WM Section 24 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Livestock Township 27 South, Range 9 East, WM Section 1 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Livestock

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 14, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
