PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65257 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Bill G. Davis of Route 2, Box 285, Baker, Oregon 97814, phone 523-5087, for the use of the waters of an unnamed drainageway and Powder River, a tributary of Snake River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 80.0 acres from the unnamed drainageway when available with any deficiency inthe available supply of water from the unnamed drainageway to be made up by appropriation from Powder River and supplemental irrigation of 30.0 acres from * that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 1, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.75 Cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Unnamed drainageway - 600 feet North and 1325 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 35, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 35, Township 8 South, Range 40 East, WM; Powder River - Baldock Newhome Ditch - 1700 feet South and 400 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 16, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, Township 9 South, Range 40 East, WM; Powder River Correl** A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * the unnamed drainageway
- ** Ditch 50 feet North and 2720 feet East from the Center Corner of Section 8, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 9 South, Range 40 East, WM in the County of Baker.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 14, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1987
