### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68103** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Crown Zellerbach Corporation, Forestry Research Division of PO Box 368, Wilsonville, Oregon 97070, phone 682-2141,** for the use of the waters of an **unnamed intermittent stream and Eola Reservoir, a tributary of King Creek,** to be \* for the PURPOSE of **irrigation of 44.3 acres**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **June 6, 1984**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.55 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **300 feet North and 900 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 13, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 6 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Polk.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-R-9965, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. and shall conform to such reasonable

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **August 14, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **86**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **87**.
