PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62731 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States, Ochoco National Forest of 2321 E. Third Street, Prineville, Oregon 97754, phone 447-3825, for the use of the waters of Ole Spring, a tributary of Pine Creek, for the PURPOSE of stockwater

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 11, 1981

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.002 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 3080 feet South and 220 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 23, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 17 South, Range 19 East, in the County of Crook.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 17 South, Range 19 East, WM Section 23 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Stockwater

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 23, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
