PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63928 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States Wallowa-Whitman National Forest of Baker Ranger District, Route 1, Box 1, Baker, Oregon 97814, phone 523-6291, Extension 266, for the use of the waters of Roadside Spring, a tributary of Deer Creek, for the PURPOSE of stockwater

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 23, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.5 gallons per minute

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 495 feet North and 1485 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 30, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 30, Township 9 South, Range 38 East, WM, in the County of Baker.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 9 South, Range 38 East, WM Section 30 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Stockwater

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87 .
