This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62241 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following

United States Mt. Hood National Forest of 2955 NW Division, Gresham, This permit is issued to Oregon 97030, phone 667-0511, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Salmon River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use in Green Canyon Campground

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

August 12, 1981

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot Der second of water

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1804 feet North and 820 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 27, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 27, Township 3 South, Range 7 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87 .
