This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62944 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

for the PURPOSE of domestic (campground)

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.004 cubic foot per second of water

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 685 feet North and 790 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 14, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 4 South, Range 10 East, W M, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 South, Range 10 East, W M Section 14 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic (campground)

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87 .
