PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63014 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States Mt. Hood National Forest of 2955 NW Division, Gresham, Oregon 97030, phone 667-0511, for the use of the waters of Deer Spring, a tributary of Wildcat Creek,

for the PURPOSE of livestock and wildlife

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 4, 1981

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second of water

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2640 feet South and 1580 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 15, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 4 South, Range 11 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 South, Range 11 East, W M Section 15 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Livestock and wildlife

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87 .
