PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68134 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

William Howard Marble of Star Route, Box 825, Gales Creek, Oregon This permit is issued to 97117, phone 357-8126, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Gales

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation of one-half acre, being 0.005 cfs for domestic and 0.01 cfs for irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 26, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 500 feet North and 950 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 23, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 2 North, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Section 23 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Township 2 North, Range 5 West, WM Domestic use for one family and one-half acre irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre, provided further water shall not be appropriated during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year except for human consumption.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 $\,$ 86 $\,$.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87 .
