## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68146** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Larry Guthrie, Agent for Carpenter Land and Cattle Company of Route 1, Box 468, Imnaha, Oregon 97842, phone 577-3220, for the use of the waters of Spring Creek and Imnaha River, being 0.16 cfs from Spring Creek and 0.33 cfs from \*** for the PURPOSE of **irrigation of 19.8 acres**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **August 6, 1984**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.49 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Diversion 1 - 750 feet North and 1250 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 23, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 23; Diversion 2 - 300 feet North and 3030 feet West of the Southeast Corner of Section 23, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23; Diversion 3 - 1200 feet South and 3370 feet West of the Northeast Corner of Section 26, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of \*\***

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- \* **Imnaha River,**
- \*\* **Section 26, all within Township 1 South, Range 48 East, WM, in the County of Wallowa.**

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **September 27, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 19 86** .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 19 87** .
