## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68150 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Stephen's College of Box 2006, Columbia, Missouri 55215, phone (314)442-2211, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Willamette River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 6, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 975 feet North 34° West and 210 feet North 57° 28' East from the Southwest Corner of Donation Land Claim 37, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 2 South, Range 1 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 South, Range 1 East, WM Section 13 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19.86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87 .
