PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68153 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Forrest H. Alter of 1417 Siskiyou, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 884-9478, for the use of the waters of Rogue River, a tributary of Pacific Ocean, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 10, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 5 feet South and 280 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 3, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 3, Township 31 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 31 South, Range 3 East, WM Section 3 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87 .
