PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68154 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions

Melvin Kaufman of 11155 Kaufman Rd., NE, Silverton, Oregon 97381, This permit is issued to phone 362-3136, for the use of the waters of Pudding River, a tributary of Willamette

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 15.5 acres and suppelmental irrigation of 8.2 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 14, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.3 Cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1100 feet South and 2000 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 8, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township & South, Range 1 West, WM Section 7 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 16.7 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.5 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4 3.0 acres 0.5 acre NE 1/4 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 2.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 provided further that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation in part the right allowed may, in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water supply provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 $\,86\,$.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87 .
