PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68179 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Forest Glen Oaks, Inc. of Route 2, Box 269, Dayton, Oregon 97114, phone 864-2160, for the use of the waters of wash water and animal waste from dairy barns and manure storage lagoon to be constructed under Application R-68178, * for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation of 62.5 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 12, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 75 gallons of water per minute

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Reservoir - 700 feet North and 1550 feet East; Diversion - 470 feet North and 1500 feet East, both from the Southwest Corner of Section 13, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 4 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre, from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-9974, provided further that although declared hereinto be for supplemental irrigation, the right may, in the interest of proper operation of the manure storage lagoon, be exercised at times when water is available at the primary source provided, that the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1987.
