PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63638 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States Forest Service, Umatilla National Forest of 2517 SW Hailey Avenue, Oregon 97801, phone 276-3811, for the use of the waters of Deadhorse Spring, a tributary of Pot Creek, for the PURPOSE of livestock and wildlife

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 14, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2400 feet North and 1600 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 26, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 26, Township 1 North, Range 37 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 North, Range 37 East, WM Section 26 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Livestock and wildlife

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87 .
