PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **64148** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **United States, Wallowa-Whitman National Forest of PO Box 490, Enterprise, Oregon 97828, phone 426-3151**, for the use of the waters of Temperance Creek, a tributary of Snake River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of **54.0 acres** and domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 10, 1982**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **1.351 cubic foot per second, being 1.35 cfs for irrigation and 0.001 cfs for domestic use for one family**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **555 feet South and 725 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 26, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 26, Township 1 North, Range 50 East, WM, in the County of Wallowa.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4-0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
