PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62696 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States, Ochoco National Forest of PO Box 490, Prineville, Oregon 97754, phone 447-6247, for the use of the waters of Walton Lake Spring,
for the PURPOSE of campground use

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 11, 1981

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.004 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1800 feet South and 1120 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 21, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 13 South, Range 20 East, WM, in the County of Crook.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 13 South, Range 20 East, WM Section 21 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Campground use
NE 1/4 NW 1/4

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 22, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
