## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **62697** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **United States, Ochoco National Forest of PO Box 490, Prineville, Oregon 97754, phone 447-6247, for the use of the waters of Begg Spring, a tributary of Begg Creek,** for the PURPOSE of **stock and wildlife**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 11, 1981**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.0017 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **4200 feet along azimuth 194° true from the Northeast Corner of Section 4, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 17 South, Range 26 East, WM, in the County of Grant.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Township 17 South, Range 26 East, WM Section 4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Stock and wildlife**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **October 22, 1985** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **86**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **87**.
