## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68007 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following 68007

Gebhard Orchards by Edwin W. and/or Franklin H. Gebhard of 446 Beebe Road, Central Point, Oregon 97502, phone 664-1841 or 664-2235, for the use of the waters of Gebhard Reservoir 2 to be constructed under Application R-68006, \* for the PURPOSE of temperature control

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from 1984 from Gebhard January 27, for stored water Reservoir 2 and April 23, 1984 for water from North and South Forks Little Butte Creek

4.0 cubic feet and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Reservoir 2 - 675 feet North and 1160 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 1, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 1, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, WM; South Fork Little Butte Creek - 600 feet South and 525 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 29, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 29, Township 36 South, Range 2 East, WM; North Fork Little Butte Creek - 30 feet North and\*\* A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Permit R-10022 and South Fork Little Butte Creek when available with any deficiency in the available supply Fouth Fork Little Butte Creek to be made up by appropriation from North Fork Little Butte Creek,

630 feet West from the E 1/4 of Section 20, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20, Township 36 South, Range 2 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

Township 37 South, Range 2 West, WM Section 1 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 13.8 acres Temperature control

> SE 1/4 NW 1/4 3.0 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 15.7 acres

The permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control (frost control) on forms furnished.

October 30, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
