PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68118** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **John C. Kasner of 1300 Morganson Road, Mosier, Oregon 97046, phone 478-3361, for the use of the waters of a spring,**

for the PURPOSE of **stockwater**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **July 16, 1984**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **750 feet South and 625 feet East from the Northwest Corner of NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 8, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 2 North, Range 12 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 North, Range 12 East, WM Section 8 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Stockwater

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **October 30, 1985** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **86**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **87**.
