## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68144 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Carl Anderson of PO Box 206, Grand Ronde, Oregon 97347, phone 879-5108 or 879-5252, for the use of the waters of Rock Creek and Cow Creek, a tributaries of South Yamhill River, being 0.01 cfs from Rock Creek during the period \* for the PURPOSE of recreation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

August 2, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Cow Creek - 1150 feet South and 2450 feet West; Rock Creek - 225 feet South and 2575 feet West; Reservoir 1 - 100 feet South and 2425 feet West; Reservoir 2 - 100 feet South and 2550 feet West all from the Northeast Corner of Section 13, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 6 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* from October 2 to March 31 of each year and 0.01 cfs from Cow Creek during the period from April 1 to October 1 of each year for maintaining each of the two reservoirs to be constructed under Application R-68143, Permit R-10024,

Township 6 South, Range 8 West, WM Section 13 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Recreation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 30, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87
