## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68163 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Orrice Adler of Route 1, Box 258, Forest Grove, Oregon 97116, phone 357-3242, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Gales Creek

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 27, 1984 for 0.005 cfs and September 27, 1984 for 0.005 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 505 feet North and 562 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 23, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM Section 26 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

provided further water shall not be appropriated during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year except for human consumption.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 30, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87
