## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68171 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Phillip F. Dahl of Fairview Route, Box 3426, Coquille, Oregon 97423, phone 396-2762, for the use of the waters of North Fork Coquille River, a tributary of Coquille River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 54.0 acres and stock, being 0.68 cfs for irrigation and 0.01 cfs for stock

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 5, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.69 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 150 feet South and 20 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 24, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 24, Township 27 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 27 South, Range 12 West, WM Section 13 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 19.0 acres	Irrigation and stock
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 8.0 acres	Irrigation and stock
Section 24 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 10.0 acres	Irrigation and stock
NW 1/4 NE 1/4 17.0 acres	Irrigation and stock

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 30, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986. Extended to October 1987 Extended to October 1, 1989 Extended to October 1, 1990

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1987. Extended to October 1, 1988
