## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64518 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife of 506 SW Mill, Portland, Oregon 97208, phone 229-5701, for the use of the waters of Ana River, a tributary of Summer Lake, for the PURPOSE of restoration of marshland and potholes for wildlife management

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 1, 1982 for 10.0 cfs and January 25, 1983 for 15.0 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 25.0 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1254 feet North and 264 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 17, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 30 South, Range 17 East, WM, in the County of Lake.
